### Romans 5: 1-5

#### Results of Justification

Therefore, since we are justified by faith,  
we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus  
Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom we have obtained  
access to this grace in which we stand; and  
we boast in our hope of sharing the glory of  
God. <sup>3</sup> And not only that, but we also boast in
